Performance Work Statement (PWS)

Command Fingerprinting Services for Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division (NAWCAD)

1.0 Introduction

The Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division (NAWCAD) has a requirement to collect and submit electronic fingerprints via the Secure Web Fingerprint Transaction (SWFT) and the Secure Web Fingerprint Transaction Plus (SWFT+) applications (or their successors), as part of the Department of Defense security clearance investigation process, to the Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA) Trusted Decision (Adjudication) [TD(A)] (or their successors) as a condition of employment, internship or contractual information and materials access.

2.0 Background

Due to the geographic spread of potential incoming employees, interns and remote working Non-National Industrial Security Program (NISP) contractors, the NAWCAD Command requires a digital fingerprinting service solution capable of providing services to individuals located within the continental United States and have those fingerprints digitally taken and transmitted via SWFT/SWFT+ (or their successors) on our behalf.

3.0 Scope

This Firm-Fixed Unit Price (fee-for-service) contract is based on a transactional level, one completed fingerprint submission to NBIS, DISS or its successor system, will be considered one transaction which will be billed at the agreed upon rate. The contractor shall provide digital fingerprint submission, both electronically captured and digitized hard-copy fingerprints via SWFT.

4.0 Requirements/Tasks

- 4.1 The contractor will provide a web-based appointment scheduling system which shows a list of available sites based on address/zip code. Appointments shall allow maximum flexibility for users.
- 4.2 The contractor will provide electronic fingerprint capture and submission services by collecting fingerprints in the required format to meet SWFT/SWFT+ and DCSA standards.
- 4.3 The fingerprint submission quality and acceptance rate by DCSA will be, at a minimum, 95% acceptance. Fingerprints that are returned unacceptable will be re-captured and re-submitted by the contractor at no cost to the Government.
- 4.4 The contractor will support nationwide SWFT/SWFT+ fingerprinting at FieldPrint locations for up to 780 personnel annually throughout the period of performance.
- 4.5 Secure Web Fingerprint Transaction (SWFT/SWFT+) submission utilizing two (2) Submitting Office Numbers (SONs) will be provided upon contract award. NAWCAD will provide the SONs as well as the Submitting Office Identification (SOI) and Intra-Government Payment and Collection (IPAC) codes that will be used during SWFT fingerprint submissions. The contractor will ensure that any changes to the SON, SOI, or IPAC codes submitted by the Contracting Officer Representative (COR) will be updated within three (3) business days.
- 4.6 The contractor will submit monthly Financial Status Reports in accordance with (IAW) CDRL A001 by the 5th day of each month. Format of the report will be mutually agreed between the contractor and

the Government to include a break-down by SON, number of fingerprint submissions for the month, and a total annual number of fingerprint submissions to date.

- 4.7 The contract shall invoice only by the actual number of prints IAW CDRL A001.

5.0 Place of Performance

All work will be completed by the Contractor at any of their locations.

6.0 Security

During performance of this contract, the contractor will have access to Privacy Act Information and Personally Identifiable Information (PII). The contractor shall safeguard all PII, and ensure this data is accessed and maintained in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

7.0 Government Furnished Equipment

The Government will not furnish any equipment for the performance of this contract. The contractor is responsible for providing all equipment required for the entire performance of this contract.
