The scope of work of the item being sought to purchase is: The City of Boise, Idaho (City) invites qualified firms or consultant teams to submit proposals to provide expert professional services for Advancing Intercity Rail and Station-Area Investment in Boise. The engagement will develop financial, economic, procurement, and implementation strategies for the Boise Cut-Off and historic Boise Depot, with emphasis on potential restoration of intercity passenger rail along the Pioneer Corridor and complementary station-area reinvestment.

- **SIGN your electronic Proposal. Proposals without written signature will not be accepted.**
- **All E-Bids must be submitted before the scheduled Proposal opening.** In the event of a technology failure, the City reserves the right to accept all Proposals submitted and electronically time stamped prior to Proposal opening. The City will require Proposal receipt document to be on file as proof of timely submission. Proposers are encouraged to confirm the successful up-load of their Proposal document. The City will not accept Proposals after the scheduled time for opening.

Group 2.2: Public Agency Clause

Instructions: Bid prices will be made available to other "Public Agencies" as defined in Section 67-2327 of the Idaho Code, to include any city or political subdivision of this state including, but not limited to counties; school districts; highway districts; port authorities; instruments of counties; cities or any political subdivision created under the laws of the State of Idaho; any agency of the state government; and any city or political subdivision of another state. It will be the responsibility of the "Public Agency" to independently contract with the vendor and/or comply with any other applicable provisions of Idaho Code governing public contracts.
